Call for Applications

The American Embassy is pleased to announce the 2018 Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program. This one-year, full-scholarship program is offered to mid-career professionals working at policy-level who have a record of leadership, a commitment to public service, and the initiative to take full advantage of a self-defined program of independent study at a leading American university.

The Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program brings accomplished professionals from developing countries to the United States at a midpoint in their careers for a one-year program of non-degree study and related professional activities. Successful applicants will be placed at participating universities in the United States for the August 2018 to June 2019 period.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for a Humphrey Fellowship, applicants must have:

- A first university degree
- Five years of substantial professional experience
- Demonstrated leadership qualities and a record of public service
- Fluency in English
- Zimbabwean citizen living and working in Zimbabwe at the time of application**

Application/Selection Process

Interested applicants must apply to the U.S. Embassy on official application forms which can be downloaded from <http://harare.usembassy.gov>. Forms and copies of degree transcripts only should be emailed to HararePAS@state.gov and received no later than June 1, 2017.

Grant Provisions

The Hubert Humphrey Fellowship provides:

- Round-trip economy international travel for the grantee.
- Tuition and university fees, medical insurance and a stipend for the grantee only.
